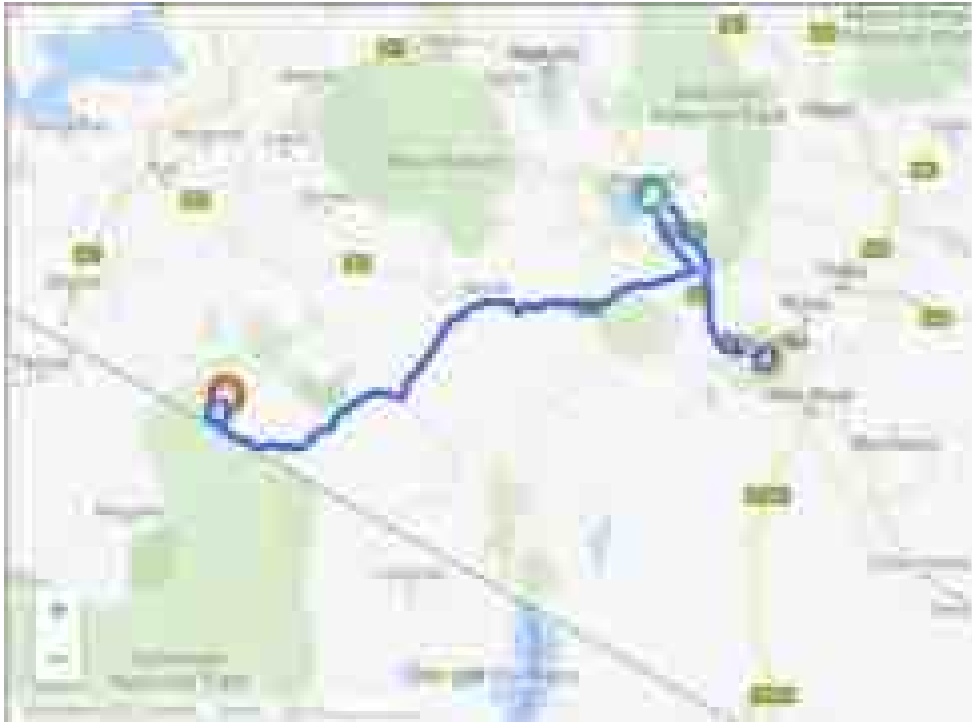

DAY 1 / DAY 2

Arrival in Nairobi late night; check in Giraffe Manor



Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be personally welcomed and fast-tracked through formalities with VIP assistance.

A private vehicle will transfer you to the iconic Giraffe Manor, one of the world's most exclusive boutique hotels. This will take around 40 minutes.

Set within 140 acres of forested sanctuary, the manor is home to a resident herd of endangered Rothschild giraffes. During breakfast and afternoon tea, these graceful animals often approach the windows — creating one of Africa's most unforgettable wildlife encounters.

Pickup at 9:30am to visit the **David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust**, where orphaned elephants are rehabilitated before returning to the wildness. The elephants can be visited from 11am for 1h. This one-hour slot is when the orphaned elephants come in for their midday milk feed and mud bath – it's the only time the public is allowed in.

Return to the Giraffe Manor in the afternoon for afternoon tea.

Your evening is at leisure, with fine dining served in the Giraffe Manor's elegant dining room.

Day 3

Lake Naivasha - A fresh water jewel in the Rift Valley



After Breakfast in Giraffe Manor a continuation of your journey towards west into the dramatic escarpments of the Great Rift Valley, descending toward the tranquil freshwater shores of Lake Naivasha. It will be a scenic drive of approx. 3-4 hours.

In the afternoon from approx. 2-5pm:

- A private boat safari across glass-like waters
- A guided walking safari on Crescent Island among giraffes and zebra

This rare opportunity to walk freely among wildlife is both exhilarating and serene.

Day 4 / 5 / 6

Into the Maasai Mara – the highlight of the Safari



After breakfast: Scenic drive to the legendary Maasai Mara National Reserve, widely regarded as Africa's finest safari destination.

Upon arrival, settle into your luxury tented safari camp — where canvas, wood, and sweeping views blend seamlessly into the surrounding wilderness. An afternoon game drive introduces you to the Mara's remarkable wildlife density. Next day (Day 5) is full of safari experience with game drives and all meals.

Morning and afternoon game drives reveal:

- Lion prides in golden light
- Elephant herds crossing open plains
- Cheetahs scanning the horizon
- And many other wild animals
- Vast migratory herds (seasonal)

Day 6 early morning starts with a game drive. Drive back to the lodge for breakfast and lunch. Check out and transfer to the airstrip for the flight back to Nairobi Wilson Airport.
